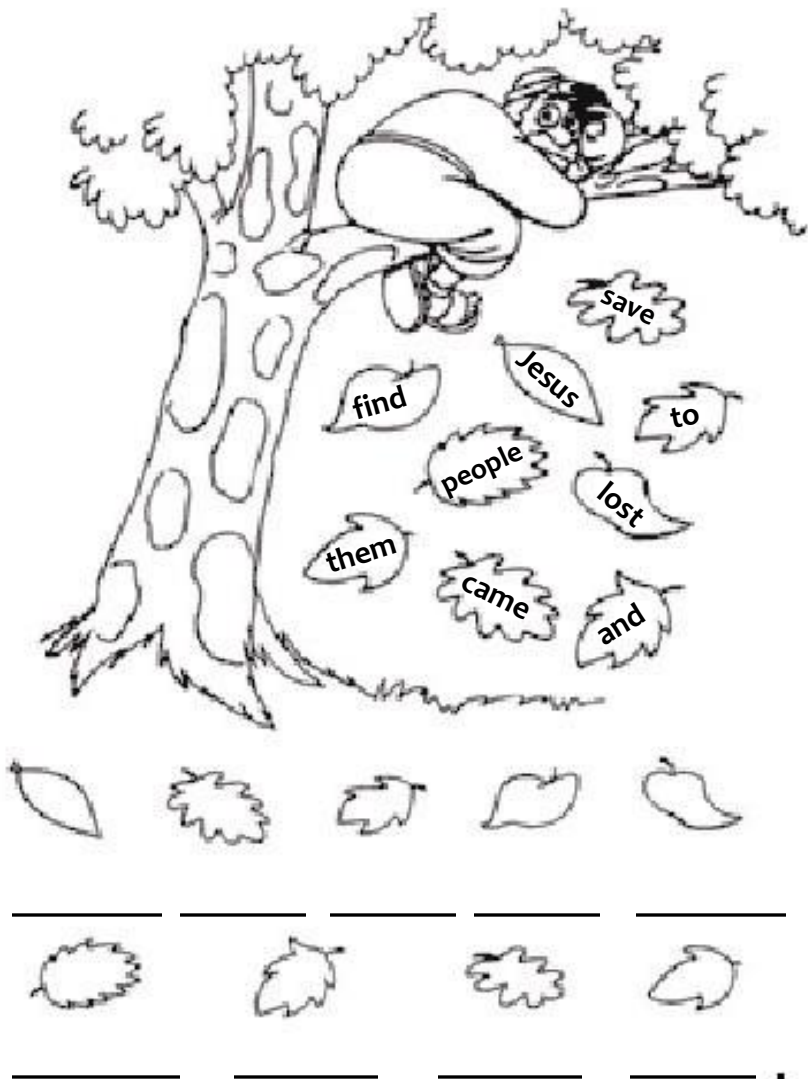

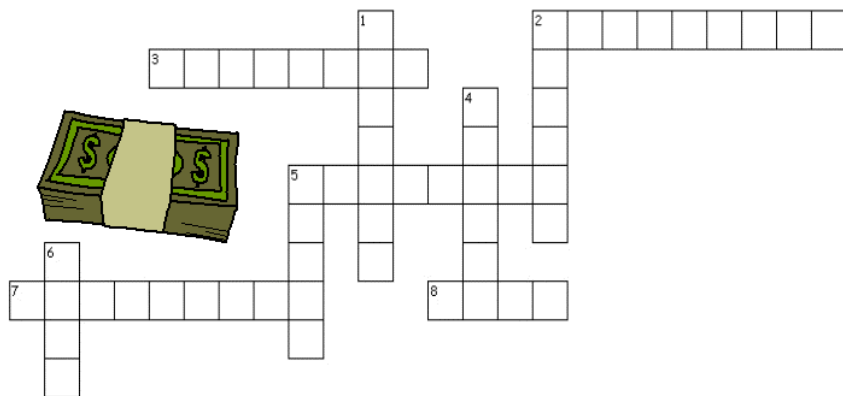
Zaccheus climbed a tree to see Jesus.

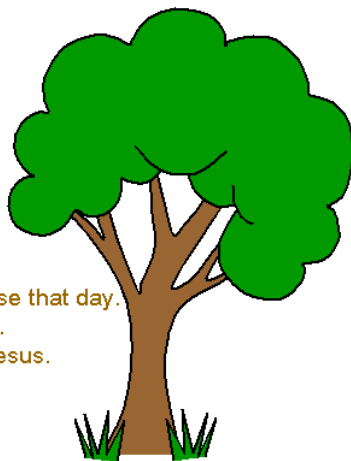


Zacchaeus Crossword
